So, this song was just released for download today by The Decemberists themselves, and it blew me away. I've listened to it now a total of three times (about to be four to double-check the lyrics).

It just now occurred to me it would be a lot of fun to learn, so I picked up my classical and went at it. It's in Em, and the chords you're going to want to grab are here (God, being in music school and majoring in jazz has made me hate tab... here they are in not-tab and relative chord fingering to make me feel better)


